An earth finger bending toward the fire finger shows the need for introspective alone time and a history of exposure to double standards

Bitten nails show poor confidence, loneliness and the inability to solve a stressful problem

A whorl or peacock's eye on the fire finger is a sure sign of artistic/design flair

A line that runs into the earth finger shows that the bearer has a lot of responsibility

A loop that drops down between the earth and fire fingers shows a serious work ethic

A square on the Jupiter mount is called a teacher's square

The angle at which your thumb departs from your hand shows your degree of confidence. 45° or less - introversion, stress 90° or more - domineering, assertive between 45° & 90° - good confidence

An array of vertical lines under the air finger are called healing stigmata and show the ability to channel energy

Bendy back thumbs show adaptability

Very active, mind cannot relax

Stiff, straight thumbs show persistence and discipline

A small fork at the end of the air line is called a writer's fork
